



Community Interpreter Course

COURSE DESCRIPTION

The purpose of this FREE course is to prepare students to become certified community interpreters.

All sessions are interactive and online. This training is in English and is a prerequisite to National Certification. This training is accepted in all 50 states and meets the requirements of many schools and state agencies to become an interpreter. Students must pass a certification exam at the end of the course to receive certification.

CLASS REQUIREMENTS:

- Must be bilingual/multilingual in English and a second language
- Must have a device with a webcam and a microphone
- Student **MUST** attend 40 hours to successfully complete the class
- Student must have a gmail account
- Register by October 1, 2026
