

Community Interpreter Course

COURSE DESCRIPTION

The purpose of this FREE course is to prepare students to become certified community interpreters.

All sessions are interactive and online. This training is all in English and is a prerequisite to National Certification. This training is accepted in all 50 states and meets the requirements of many schools and state agencies to become an interpreter. Students must pass a certification exam at the end of the course to receive certification. Additional training beyond this course is needed for medical certification.

CLASS REQUIREMENTS:

- Must be bilingual/multilingual in English and a second language
- Must have a device with a webcam and a microphone
- Student MUST attend 90% of the training
- · Must have a gmail account
- Register by January 15, 2026
- FOR TEACHER USE: Must have an ABE Reading Level 5
